The CCACC Health Center (previously known as Pan Asian Volunteer Health Clinic, PAVHC) is a charity clinic under the Chinese Culture and Community Service Center (CCACC), a 501(C)(3) non-profit organization. The clinic provides access to healthcare for all community members.

Our Community Health Programs:

- **PAVHC Volunteer Clinic**  
provide primary cares and essential health service for uninsured, low income Montgomery County residents
- **S.T.O.P B Project**  
provides screening, treatment, outreach and education for hepatitis B
- **Mental Health 360**  
provides psychiatric service, psychotherapy, health education on mental health
- **Program to Encourage Active Rewarding Livings (PEARLs)**  
provides 1:1 case management for depressed, socially isolated seniors in our community
- **Integrated Chronic Care Management Program (ICCM)**  
provides comprehensive care management for patients who have multiple uncontrolled chronic conditions
- **Village Program**  
provide education, counseling, workshop, peer support group for family with demented love ones or children with special needs
